

A Study of the Epistles of Paul

(NT Survey Lesson 184--Titus 2)

Introduction: God has redeemed his people to be zealous for good deeds. In this chapter Paul gives Titus some specific things to teach to various groups in the church in order that they may know what God desires of them.

Lesson aim: To know how we may adorn the doctrine of God in our lives.

Instructions to various age groups--Tit. 2:1-8

1. Thought question: Why do you think Paul is so careful in telling each age group how to live?
2. What was "fitting" for each age group?
 - a. Aged men
 - b. Aged women
 - c. Young women
 - d. Young men

Instructions to slaves--Tit. 2:9-10

1. What were servants to do?
2. Describe the attitude of the servant in his serving.
3. Why were servants commanded to do this?

Why Christians should adorn the doctrine of God--Tit. 2:11-15

1. To whom had the grace of God appeared? What does it bring?
2. How does the grace of God teach us?

3. What does God's grace teach us to do?
4. How does Paul describe Christ Jesus?
5. What did Christ do to save us?
6. For what purpose did Christ save us?
7. With what attitude should we engage in good works (deeds)?
