Lesson aim: To show the reasons for John's death and to present further evidence of Jesus' divinity

Antipas' mistaken identification of Jesus--Mt. 14:1-2; Mark 6:14-16; Lk. 9:7-9

- 1. What testimony did the wicked king Herod give about Jesus?*
- 2. What can we learn about guilt from Herod's reaction?*

Earlier imprisonment and beheading of John the Baptist--Mt. 14:3-12; Mk. 6:17-29

- 1. What lessons can one learn about marriage from John's rebuke of Herod?*
- 2. What can we learn about John's preaching style?*
- 3. What are some things that can result when one disagrees with the truth being taught?*

Withdrawal from Galilee--Mt. 14:13-14; (Mk. 6:31-34; Lk. 9:10b-11; Jn. 6:1-3)

- 1. What does this section teach us about Jesus? How might we imitate this example?*

Feeding the five thousand--Mt. 14:15-21; (Mk. 6:35-44; Lk.

9:12-17; Jn. 6:4-13)

1. *What manifestations of divine power are illustrated in the feeding of the five thousand?*
2. *What did Jesus always do before eating? What lesson can we learn from this?*

Jesus rejects the attempts of the masses to make him King over them--Mt. 14:22-23; (Mk. 6:45-46; Jn. 6:14-15)

1. *Why did the Jews want to make Jesus king? Why did Jesus refuse their attempt? How might this help us in dealing with the premillennial viewpoint?*
