Healings at Gennesaret--Mt. 14:34-36; (Mk. 6:53-56)

1. *What extraordinary feature of Jesus' healings is mentioned?*

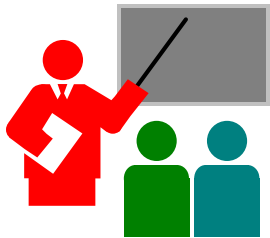
Discourse on the true bread of life--Jn. 6:22-59

1. *What does Jesus' rebuke of the multitude tell us about His purpose for working miracles?*
2. *Outline the main points Jesus made in His sermon on the "true bread".*

The masses turn from following Christ--Jn. 6:60-71

- 1. Why was Jesus rejected? What implications does this have for dispensational schemes that assert that Jesus intended to set up an earthly kingdom?*
- 2. What lesson might be learned from those who stayed with Jesus?*
