Further ministry in Perea

Lesson aim: To examine the teaching of Jesus concerning His association with sinners and one's attitude toward wealth.

Parables in defense of association with sinners--Lk. 15:1-32

- 1. What common theme runs through all the parables in this reading?
- 2. What might we learn from the conduct of the prodigal son? Of the elder brother?

A parable about the proper use of money--Lk. 16:1-13

- 1. What particular feature of this steward did Jesus commend and urge His disciples to imitate?
- 2. How do we "make friends" for ourselves by means of unrighteous mammon?
- 3. What are the true riches of which Jesus speaks?

Warnings about the danger of wealth (The rich man and Lazarus)--Lk. 16:14-31

- 1. Why did the Pharisees scoff at Jesus' teaching about stewardship? What warning did Jesus give them?
- 2. What is the main point of the story of the rich man and Lazarus? Is this a parable or history?
