

## **First Witnesses of the Resurrection**

**Lesson aim: To examine the evidence for the bodily resurrection of Jesus.**

**The tomb visited by the women--Mt. 28:1; (Mk. 16:1)**

**The stone rolled away--Mt. 28:2-4**

- 1. What explanation did Matthew give for the removal of the stone from the tomb?*

**The tomb found to be empty by the women--Mt. 28:5-8; (Mk. 16:2-8; Lk. 24:1-8; Jn. 20:1)**

- 1. What testimony did the angels of God give the women who first came to the tomb? What proof did they give to support their claim?*

**The tomb found to be empty by Peter and John--Lk. 24:9-11; (Jn. 20:2-10)**

- 1. Were the apostles disposed to believe the testimony of the women?*
- 2. What evidence of resurrection did Peter and John note when they came to the tomb?*

**Appearance to Mary Magdalene--Mk. 16:9-11; (Jn. 20:11-18)**

- 1. What did the person at the tomb say to Mary that indicated that he was Jesus?*

## **Appearance to the other women--Mt. 28:9-10**

## **Report of the soldiers to the Jewish authorities--Mt. 28:11-15**

1. *How does the report of the soldiers contact support the claim that Jesus was raised?*

## **Appearance to two disciples traveling to Emmaus--Mk. 16:12-13; (Lk. 24:13-32)**

1. *How did Jesus help these disciples to understand the fact that He had been raised from the dead?*
2. *What sign did Jesus give to confirm the message He had delivered to these disciples?*

## **Report of the two disciples to the rest (1 Cor. 15:5)--Lk. 24:33-35**

1. *To what other person did Jesus appear personally after his resurrection from the dead?*
