

Brief Ministry in Samaria

Lesson aim: To show how Jesus led others to salvation through faith in Him as the Messiah, fulfilling the prophecies that He would be Savior of man

Discussion with a Samaritan woman--Jn. 4:5-26

- 1. What claims does Jesus make for himself in His conversation with the Samaritan woman?*
- 2. Trace the developing faith of the Samaritan woman from her first introduction to Jesus to her testimony to others about Him.*
- 3. What is the living water Jesus gives? Why is that term a fitting description of it?*
- 4. What does it mean to worship "in spirit and in truth"? How does this answer the woman's question about "where" one should worship?*
- 5. What helpful ideas can you glean from this section about teaching others?*

- 1. What points does Jesus make about evangelism in this section?*

Evangelization of Sychar--Jn. 4:39-42

- 1. What conclusion did the Samaritans reach about Jesus?*
- 2. What can we learn from this story about how to convert others?*
