

# **A Study of the General Epistles**

## **NT Survey Lesson 151—Hebrews 9**

**Introduction:** By the symbols of the OT tabernacle and its worship the Holy Spirit was revealing that entrance into the actual presence of God was not yet made possible. However, through Christ such is now possible, and that because Jesus, our high priest, passed through the heavens with His own blood as an offering given in our behalf.

**Lesson aim:** To show how Jesus has obtained eternal redemption for all those who have trusted in Him.

### **The OT worship and tabernacle taught that the way into God's presence had not yet been made possible—Heb. 9:1-10**

1. What two things did the first covenant have? (v. 1)
2. What furnishings were found in the first part of the tabernacle (the holy place)? (v. 2) What furnishings were found in the second part (the most holy place)? (v. 3-5)
3. What did the priests do in the first part? (v. 6) How often?
4. What did the high priest do in the second part? (v. 7) How often?
5. What lesson was the Holy Spirit teaching by this arrangement? (v. 8)  
The tabernacle was a \_\_\_\_\_ for the present time.
6. Could the sacrifices offered by the priests make the worshipper perfect in conscience? (v. 9) Why or why not? (v. 10)

### **Jesus has made possible the way into the presence of God by the sacrifice of Himself—Heb. 9:11-22**

1. Through what tabernacle did our high priest enter? (v. 11) What sacrifice did he take with him? (v. 12)
2. What did Jesus obtain by His sacrifice? (v. 12)

3. What did the blood of goats and bulls cleanse? (v. 13) What will the blood of Christ cleanse? (v. 14)
4. Because of Jesus' offering, he is the mediator of what? (v. 15) This is in order that those who have been called may receive what?
5. What must happen before a covenant can be in force? (v. 16-17)
6. The first covenant was not inaugurated without what? (v. 18) What did Moses do when the first covenant was inaugurated? (v. 19-21)
7. What lesson may one learn from the use of blood in the OT? (v. 22)

### **Christ's offering was made once for all time—Heb. 9:23-28**

1. It was necessary for the heavenly things to be cleansed with what? (v. 23)
2. Where did Christ appear to present His offering? (v. 24) Was it necessary for Him to offer His offering often? (v. 25)
3. Jesus has appeared at the consummation of the ages to do what? (v. 26)
4. It is appointed unto man to do what? (v. 27) What comes after that?
5. Christ was offered \_\_\_\_\_ to bear the sins of many. (v. 28) He shall appear a second time for what purpose? (v. 28)
