

A Study of the General Epistles (N.T. Survey Lesson 233-Revelation 19)

Introduction: In chapter nineteen the celebration of victory begins, even before all of the enemies of God are judged. It is clear that God will bring to an end all those who have persecuted and killed his people and that His kingdom will triumph. In response the hosts of heaven cry out, “Hallelujah!”

Lesson aim: To appreciate the praise of which God is worthy for his victory over all His enemies.

The four-fold hallelujah--Rev. 19:1-10

1. What word declares the praise of the great multitude to God? What do they say belong to the Lord? Why?
2. What message accompanies the second “hallelujah”? (v. 3)
3. What two groups are pictured as praising God in heaven? (v. 4) What command is sent forth from God’s throne?
4. What does the great multitude declare about God? What event do they say has come? Who is the bride and how did she prepare herself for the wedding feast?
5. What blessing was John told to write? What did the angel tell John when he fell before him at the hearing of the angel’s message?
6. What does the angel say is the spirit of prophecy? Therefore, who should we worship?

Jesus’ cloud coming is pictured--Rev. 19:11-21

1. What color horse did John see? What were the names of the rider? What is he pictured as doing? (v. 11)
2. How is Jesus described in v. 12-13? What might each of these descriptions symbolize?
3. Describe the armies that followed Jesus.

4. What weapon does Jesus use to smite the nations? What else will he do? (v. 15)

5. What name is written on his robe and thigh?

6. What does the angel standing in the sun call upon the birds to do?

7. What does the beast and the false prophet do? What happens to them? What happens to those who followed them?
