

## **A Study of the Prophets**

### **O.T. Survey Lesson 132--Isaiah 49:1-26**

**Introduction:** Chapters 49-57 of Isaiah center around the coming of the divine Servant first mentioned in chapter 42 and the glory of redeemed Zion. This second "servant song" in chapter 49 presents the Christ in His worldwide mission of salvation and the effect upon the Jewish people.

**Lesson aim:** To understand Isaiah's prophetic picture of Jesus as savior of the whole world.

#### **God commissions His servant to save the world--Isaiah 49:1-12**

1. When was the Servant called and named? (v. 1)
2. How does the Servant describe himself in v. 2?
3. How does God refer to the Servant? (v. 3) What did He purpose to do through this servant?
4. How did the Servant feel about his work? (v. 4)
5. What had the Servant's mission been? (v. 5-6)  
What new mission does God give Him? (v. 6)
6. How is the Servant described in v. 7? Who is pictured as bowing down to the servant?
7. What does God say He will make the Servant? (v. 8) What will His message be? (v. 9)
8. What will be the result of the Servant's work? (v. 10-12)
9. Why are the earth and mountain encouraged to rejoice? (v. 13)
10. Who is the Servant of which Isaiah speaks?

**Israel is encouraged to see God's Servant as  
an indication of God's love in saving them--  
Isaiah 49:14-26**

1. What does Zion say? (v. 14) How does the Lord respond? (v. 15)
2. What will Israel's enemies do? (v. 17-19)
3. What is God pictured as giving to His people? (v. 20-21)
4. What does God predict will happen? (v. 22-23)
5. What does God say He will do to those who have been hostile to His people? (v. 24-26)
